Primary and post-primary schools are invited to write a short drama based around any aspect of the events of 1916, film the performance and submit the short video to RTE. A public vote will be launched to select the best plays, with the winning schools invited to perform them on the stage of the Abbey Theatre in Spring 2016.

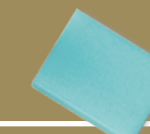
Film Scannáin

Is there a budding Neil Jordan in your school? Primary schools are invited to produce a short film based on any aspect of 1916, with prizes awarded to two winning schools as part of the Film in School awards.

Is bliain an-tábhachtach inár stair í 2016. Ar an bhliain seo chugainn beidh muid ag comóradh cuimhneachán céad bliain Éirí Amach 1916, tráth cinniúnach i dtriail na hÉireann ar an neamhspleáchas, le clár uathúil spreagúil.

Is cuireadh é Éire 2016: Clár Comórtha Céad Bliain chuig chuile dhuine, idir óg is aosta, bheith páirteach linn i mbliain ina mbeidh muid ag comóradh, ag plé agus ag scrúdú. Beidh deis agat ar feadh na bliana páirt a ghlacadh i raon leathan tionscadal agus gníomhaíochtaí spreagúla, ag tosú le himeachtaí 1916 agus ag bogadh ar aghaidh go dtí do mhianta do thodhchaí na hÉireann.

The National Flag An Bhratach Náisiúnta

Did you know that our national flag – the tricolour of green, white and orange – was designed by US Army General Thomas Francis Meagher in 1848 and was first flown in Waterford? The 1916 centenary year is a unique opportunity to discover the origin of our national emblem, why these colours were chosen and what they signify for us today. To mark this special occasion, every primary and special school in the country will be presented with a specially made flag, delivered by members of our Defence Forces. Secondary schools will receive a flag at a special ceremony next year, in conjunction with the Thomas Meagher Foundation. We have also developed a special online resource pack on the flag and our other national symbols which will be made available to schools.

An raibh a fhios agat gurb é Thomas Francis Meagher, Ginearál in Arm na Stáit Aontaithe, a dhear ár mbratach trí dhath náisiúnta sa bhliain 1848 agus gurb i bPort Láirge a cuireadh ar foluain í den chéad uair? Is deis uathúil é cuimhneachán céad bliain 1916 chun foghlaim faoi bhunús ár suaitheantais náisiúnta, an fáth gur roghnaíodh na dathanna sin agus an chiall atá leo sa lá atá inniu ann. Leis an ócáid speisialta seo a chomóradh, bronnfar bratach, a rinneadh go speisialta agus a bheidh seachadta ag baill d'Óglaigh na hÉireann, ar gach bunskoil agus scoil speisialta sa tír. Gheobhaidh na meánscoileanna bratach ag searmanas speisialta an bhliain seo chugainn, i gcomhar le Fondúireacht Thomas Meagher. Tá pacáiste acmhainní ar líne speisialta curtha le chéile againn freisin maidir leis an mbratach agus ár siombailí náisiúnta eile, a chuirfear ar fáil do na scoileanna.

Proclamation for a New Generation Forógra do Ghluín Nua

At four minutes past noon on Easter Monday, April 24th 1916, Pádraig Pearse read the Proclamation of the Republic outside the GPO on Dublin's Sackville Street, now O'Connell Street. This was a pivotal moment in our history which still resonates strongly today. The Proclamation remains an important and influential manifesto for a new republic. Every primary and post-primary school is invited to write a new Proclamation, of up to 600 words, which reflects the values, ideals and hopes of the Generation of 2016. Each school may choose to write one for the whole school or each class can create their own Proclamation.

Ag ceithre nóiméad tar éis meánlae Luan Cása, an 24 Aibreán 1916, léigh Pádraig Mac Piarais amach Forógra na Poblachta taobh amuigh d'Ard-Oifig an Phoist ar Shráid Saicbhíll, Sráid Uí Chonaill sa lá atá inniu ann, i mBaile Átha Cliath. Ba thráth cinniúach inár stair é, ceann lena bhfuil dáimh láidir againn go fóill. Is forógra tábhachtach do phoblacht nua é fiú sa lá atá inniu ann, agus ceann a bhfuil tionchar nach beag aige. Tá cuireadh ag gach bunskoil agus iar-bhunskoil Forógra nua a chumadh, suas le 600 focal ar fad, ina léirítear luachanna, idéil agus mianta Ghluín 2016. Is féidir le gach scoil ceann a scríobh don scoil uile nó d'fhéadfadh gach rang a Forógra féin a chumadh.

Ancestry Project Tionscadal Sinsearachta

Where was your family in 1916? Were they involved in the Easter Rising or were they across the world, unaware of the events happening in Ireland? You can find out in 2016. Play the role of detective and trace your family tree, discover the secret histories and untold stories of your parents and grandparents. Find out what was happening in your local community in 1916 and embark on a trail of discovery using the resources of our national cultural institutions. The Schools Collection will provide you with another opportunity to be a historical detective and feed in your local history, or what you have discovered through other projects, to a central platform.

Cá raibh do theaghlach in 1916? Cá raibh baint acu le hÉirí Amach na Cásca nó an raibh siad ar an taobh eile den domhan, gan eolas ar bith acu ar an méid a bhí ag titim amach in Éirinn? Is féidir leat é sin a fháil amach in 2016. Lig ort féin gur bleachttaire thú agus déan do chraobh ginealaigh a rianú, aimsigh stair rúnda agus scéalta ceilte do thuismitheoirí agus seantuismitheoirí. Faigh amach cad a bhí ag tarlú i do phobal áitiúil sa bhliain 1916 agus tabhair faoi aistear taiscéalaíochta trí úsáid a bhaint as acmhainní ár bhforais chultúrtha náisiúnta. Le Baillúchán na Scoileanna beidh deis eile agat bheith i do bhleachttaire staire agus stair do cheantair áitiúil, nó cibé atá foghlamtha agat trí thionscadail eile, a chur ar fáil ar ardán lámach.

Proclamation Day Lá an Fhorógra

Date for your diary! Tuesday 15th March 2016 is Proclamation Day. This is the moment when every school in the country is invited to share the results of their 'Proclamation for a New Generation', and all other creative projects relating to 1916 that the student body have developed. The day will begin with a raising of the flag, followed by a reading of the Proclamation. Students will then have an opportunity to share ideas, showcase their creative work, whether it is a theatre, dance, visual art or spoken word piece, and celebrate this unique moment, together, as a nation.

Breac síos i do dhialann é seol Lá an Fhorógra é Dé Máirt, an 15 Márta 2016. Seo an lá nuair a roinnfidh gach scoil sa tír a 'Forógra do Ghluín Nua', chomh maith le gach tionscadal cruthaitheach eile bainteach le 1916 atá forbartha ag na mic léinn. Cuirfear tús leis an lá nuair a ardófar an bhratach agus canfar Amhrán na bhFiann, agus ina dhiaidh sin beidh lá oscailte ann do thuismitheoirí, múinteoirí, cairde agus mic léinn lena goid smaointe a roinnt, a goid oibre cruthaithe a chur ar taispeáint, cibé acu is piosa amharclannaíochta, damhsa, amharc-ealaíne nó focail labhartha í, agus an nóiméad uathúil seo a chéiliúradh le chéile, mar náisiún.

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
